Located just 30 minutes from the downtown Vancouver, Cypress Mountain offers outdoor enthusiasts plenty of activities including skiing, snowboarding, cross country skiing, snow tubing, snowshoeing, summer hiking.

Cypress Mountain provides; ***"Vancouver's Only Big Mountain Experience"***. Cypress Mountain is the ideal place to tackle adventure or learn a new sport. Cypress Mountain offers 52 runs for skiers and snowboarders and snowshoeing of all abilities as well as 19 kilometers of groomed and track-set trails for fans of Nordic skiing & snowshoeing. Drop-in and multi-day lessons are also available for all activities on the mountain, and equipment rentals are available. The knowledgeable and experienced staff will ensure a safe and fun time no matter what your skill level.

Cypress Mountain was the official freestyle skiing and snowboard venue for the 2010 Olympic Winter Games. Freestyle skiing events included aerials, moguls and ski cross, while snowboard events include half-pipe, parallel giant slalom and snowboard cross. The Mountain was transformed into a world-class recreation mountain, with the addition of a magnificent timber framed Day lodge, 40 hectares of new terrain, a new high-speed chairlift, parking upgrades, Terrain Park and much more.

CRITICAL DATES & TIMES

BANQUET ROOMS

Event spaces are assigned based on the number of anticipated guests. If projected counts increase or decrease, Cypress Mountain reserves the right to change the location to one that is more suitable for the event if necessary. No items may be attached to walls, ceilings, or floors in any public space or function room without the prior consent of the Cypress Mountain Events Coordinator. The location of your event will be determined by Cypress Mountain three hours prior to the start time based on existing or predicted weather conditions. All resort buildings at Cypress Mountain are smoke free. Smoking will only be permitted in designated outdoor areas.

PRICING & SERVICES

- All advertised pricing is subject to change.
- Cypress Mountain will guarantee pricing 45 days prior to the scheduled function.
- All food and beverages must be provided by Cypress Mountain. Our liquor license prohibits guests from bringing alcoholic beverages into our licensed establishment.
- All meals are served at a specified serving time and will be in the servery for no more than two hours. Food prepared is to be consumed at the function and may not be removed from the event.
- Planned buffet style meal functions include complimentary non-alcoholic beverages which may include coffee, assorted teas, juices, or sodas.
- Banquet charges are applied to a master bill unless prior arrangements have been made.
- We accept most major credit cards. Groups requesting tax-exempt status must submit the appropriate documentation prior to the event.
- All food and beverage pricing is subject to 20% gratuity and 12% HST sales tax.

MISCELLANEOUS

The client assumes full responsibility for the conduct of all guests in attendance and for damage to any part of Cypress Mountain premises or for theft of Cypress Mountain property. Cypress Mountain is not liable for loss, theft, or damage to property belonging to our guests.

The client agrees to conduct the function in full compliance with resort rules and applicable provincial and federal laws. Cypress Mountain reserves the right to refuse any booking it considers inappropriate or inconsistent with the values, well-being, or reputation of Cypress Mountain.

The client is responsible for ensuring disposal of waste and recyclables into the appropriate containers generated by the event and its attendees. At the conclusion of the event, the venue and surrounding areas must be cleaned and returned to a condition equal or better than the condition prior to the onset of event activities. Failure to perform adequate clean-up and/or repair damages to Cypress Mountain property and facilities will result in billing the client at full cost recovery rates for clean-up and/or repair.

A deposit of 10% (minimum \$500.00) and credit card number is required in order to confirm the event booking and hold the space requested for your event. Cypress Mountain reserves the right to release the room(s) if payment terms are not met. A 50% deposit for agreed upon food items must be paid no less than seven (7) days prior to your event. A damage deposit may be requested for entertainment

provided by the client. For your convenience, we have provided a Preferred Entertainment List (PEL) which does not require a damage deposit.

Anyone who appears to be under 25 years of age will be asked to supply at least two valid pieces of Government identification. Anyone appearing intoxicated will not be served.
